Welcome to the Soham Village College extracurricular clubs and activities programme for the summer term.

How to enrol

Please complete the enrolment form at the back of this brochure and return with payment in a sealed envelope marked "After School Clubs and Activities" to the Student Services Office, Lodeside. Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Unless we contact your child, please assume that your enrolment has been accepted. **Please note that enrolments must be received before your child attends the activity. Students will be unable to participate unless an enrolment form has been received along with payment where appropriate.**

It is not necessary to enrol to use the Chill Zone, the Resource Centre or for Youth Service activities. (More information about these sessions later in this brochure.) Please ensure you enrol for all other after school activities even if there is no charge. This is to ensure accuracy of registers in the event of an emergency.

Term Dates

Club dates are detailed alongside each activity description where possible. Where no dates are shown, details are still being finalized, so students should check with the relevant member of staff. In order to minimize costs and keep fees low, we prefer not to give refunds for an occasional cancellation. If a high level of cancellations occur, the Business Manager has the discretion to authorise refunds where appropriate.

Fees

Where possible clubs are offered free of charge and any fees are kept to a minimum. Where payment causes difficulty, a subsidy may be available. For further information please contact Mrs Hammond in the Student Services Office, Lodeside.

Students in receipt of the G2G card can use their card to pay for any club or activity included in this brochure.

If you are eligible for Tax Credits, and your child is 15 or younger, you may be able to claim some of the fees as "approved activity based childcare costs". For more information contact the Tax Credit Helpline on 0845 300 3900. You will need to quote the name of your childcare provider (Soham Village College) and the registration number (110909).

The Resource Centre

The Resource Centre will be open Monday to Friday after school from 3–4pm. There is a quiet working area for homework. PCs and books can be accessed with librarian help.

Youth Team

Active Citizens in Schools – If any student wishes to set up any kind of student led activity to gain either a 25 hour certificate or 50 hour certificate, please contact the Youth Office for more details and we will assist you with this. These projects need to have a positive impact on the school or community i.e. fundraising and community improvement. A good example of this is the Stage Chance pantomimes which have been run by students for the last 5 years.

Arts Award – The youth team will be delivering Arts Award for anyone who is interested in gaining it at either bronze or silver level. This is a very practical qualification which is nationally recognised, based around either music, drama, dance and art. You do not need experience in arts; it's all about trying something new. Drop-in sessions run every other Wednesday in the Lode Centre 6pm-7pm.

Senior youth club - Wednesday evenings 7pm-9pm (term time only). Various activities for 13 -16 year olds including pool, table tennis, Wii, Xbox and coffee bar.

Junior youth club – Friday afternoons 3:15 -5pm. (term time only). Various activities for 10 – 13 year olds including pool, table tennis, Wii, Xbox and coffee bar.

After School Activities

MONDAY

Classical Civilisation GCSE 3.15—4.15pm B3 Dr Back. Students of all abilities are able to participate and succeed in a subject which addresses a variety of topics including a study of aspects of the ancient world, ranging from the archaeological excavations of Pompeii and the very ancient site of Mycenae, the latter heavily influenced by the Egyptians. Art, Textiles and Craft Club 3-4.30pm L8 Mrs Loasby, Mrs Cleland & Miss Day. All students welcome. This class gives pupils the chance to enjoy art, craft and textile activities in L8.
