# ***How will grades be awarded?***

*There will be no GCSE exams this year. Instead, schools have been asked to put forward Centre Assessed Grades.*

*These grades will be based on the evidence of your performance over the GCSE course so far and the assessments you will do in the summer term.*

*We have been very fortunate to have had an uninterrupted Autumn 2020 term where we were able to run a full mock exam series and get robust, reliable data to help support the grade awarding process. But, it is important you understand that 6<sup>th</sup> form and college grade predictions issued earlier in the year are not the same as the Centre Assessed Grades which we will have to submit on 18<sup>th</sup> June.*

*In place of final exams, the grades put forward to the exam board must be based on valid assessments you have taken. These can include mocks, coursework, practicals and other assessments. It is important that we have enough evidence of the grade you are working at to support the centre's assessment.*

*For this reason, the first summer half term will involve taking a series of classroom based assessments in every subject. These will contribute to your final grade.*



# ***What will these summer term assessments be like?***

- *The assessments will be classroom based*
- *They will look at a specific section of the course*
- *They will take no longer than one lesson each to complete*
- *You will most likely have at least two per subject*
- *This means you will have multiple assessments in a day in some weeks*
- *They will contribute towards your final grade*

# ***What am I expected to be doing?***

- *You will need to prepare for them*
- *In a normal exam year, a year 11 student would be working hard independently to learn the relevant material. Whilst you will not have the same volume of content to cover, you are expected to be working at least as hard as you did to prepare for mocks (or more if you know you didn't do enough and you have a point to prove)*
- *Use this guide to work out when your assessments are*
- *Take note of the topics you will be assessed on, fill in the calendar attached with dates of when your assessments are*
- *Revise in the Easter holidays*
- *Plan when you will be working independently when term starts again*

## Subject: History

### What topics do I need to look at?

- Crime & Punishment through time (not including Whitechapel)
- Life in Germany 1919 - 1939

### What will the assessments be like?

Two 20 mark Crime & Punishment questions lasting 40 minutes each. Students are familiar with these and know them as '16 markers'. The extra 4 marks are for spelling, punctuation, grammar and terminology.

One 36 mark question from Life in Germany. This is actually split into 4 questions on the same theme and is based around sources and interpretations. This will take place over two lessons and total 60 minutes.

### When will the assessments be?

In the six weeks following the Easter break. See below for specific dates.

## **Subject: Physical Education (GCSE PE)**

### **What topics do I need to look at?**

Paper 1 (All content taught in Year 10):

- Applied anatomy and physiology
- Physical training.

Paper 2 (Most of the content taught in year 11)

- Socio-cultural influences
- Sports psychology

You will not be assessed in Health, Fitness and wellbeing.

### **What will the assessments be like?**

You will sit two mini assessments. Paper 1 will be 30 minutes (30 marks) and will assess content taught in year 10. Paper 2 will also be 30 minutes (30 marks) and will assess content taught in year 11. The mini assessments will include AO1, AO2 and AO3 content which includes multiple choice questions, short answers and an extended 6 mark question.

To award your final grade we will use a combination of your mini-assessment, plus your practical marks and coursework mark to decide what to award you.

### **When will the assessments be?**

Your teachers have planned a number of revision lessons to help you to before the mini assessments, these will take place leading up to the mini-assessments.

Paper 1 = Friday 30<sup>th</sup> April, period 2

Paper 2 = Friday 21<sup>st</sup> May, period 3

### **Where can I go to if I want to do independent revision?**

Please speak to your teacher if you are interested in additional revision and they will direct you.

If you haven't already bought one we have specific OCR GCSE PE revision books available from our finance office.

## Anxiety and stress

Some stress isn't always a bad thing. We all need periods of stress to build resilience and to see what we are capable of achieving; it focuses us at a time when it matters.

However, this is not a 'normal' year. We know the recent lockdown has affected people in a huge variety of ways. We want you to find a balance between recognising these assessments do matter (as they will contribute towards your grade) but also recognising you have already done a large proportion of the work. These assessments are just a part of the overall picture of the standard you have shown you are working at and we already have a strong picture of your achievement.

The assessments are short. Your time in class will be spent preparing for them and there is guidance in this booklet about how to prepare independently. Below are some tips that we think will help but the last one is probably the most important! Don't suffer in silence; there is a wealth of support available if you should feel that you need it.

### What can you do?

- **Attend school (where possible)** - It sounds obvious but you will become more anxious if you miss lessons where the teacher is preparing you for the upcoming assessments
- **Revise** - This will give you more confidence in your ability to perform in the exam
- **Sleep**- Revising until the early hours won't help anyone. You won't sleep well, which means in the morning you're tired and grumpy and cannot perform properly in any type of assessment
- **Moderate your phone use!** - Checking your notifications late into the evening is distracting and the light from your phone/ tablet/ laptop actually tricks the brain into thinking the light is morning sunlight and 'wakes' you up. Plus who knows what someone has tagged you in or written on your wall. You don't need that drama!
- **Speak to us!**- Every year we have students who struggle with anxieties. You're not on your own! Pop in, email us, ask your tutor to email/ speak to us, ask parents to call in. However, you need to do it, let us know. Talking to someone will always make you feel better. We've got so many tips and tricks but unless we know about you we can't help!



# How do I revise?

The key message when revising is that it must be **active** and not passive. Passive would be just reading the revision guide then finishing and going to watch TV. Active revision is anything that involves thinking, making a decision or doing.

### Instead of just reading it and then having a cup of tea...

- ***Can you reduce the information down to half the size in note form? Can you reduce it further down to just keywords?***
- ***Can you draw pictures to help you remember it?***
- ***Can you summarise the information in 5 key points then put them in order of importance?***
- ***Can you draw a mind map and link the information on a topic together?***
- ***Can you turn the page of information into a 10 question quiz that you can get someone to test you on?***
- ***Can you make flash cards with keywords on one side and definitions on the other?***
- ***Can you make a podcast about the thing you are learning about?***



### *How do I revise?*

Once you feel like you've revise a topic, you need to **test yourself** to see if you really have and practice applying that knowledge. If the subject you are revising for involves writing them you must practice writing your answers

You can do this by answering questions in the revision guides, or by answering the relevant pages in a workbook or internet site.

It is extremely important that you mark the questions yourself – there is no point in doing questions if you don't know if they are right or not

**Exam practice** – build up to trying exams, there are not many practice papers so use them wisely! Make sure you mark them afterwards – get help from someone if you struggle. If you can't help looking at the answers, give them to someone responsible!
