

Soham Village College Summer School

The 2021 Summer School ran from Monday 23 August to Friday 27 August accommodating 94 students over five days. The five days followed this schedule:

Monday: SEND inclusion day

A day designed to help year 6 SEND students familiarise themselves with the learning and support on offer at the school. The day included science and design technology lessons with students supported by teaching staff, teaching assistants and Year 9 peer mentors.

Tuesday and Wednesday: Year 6 to 7 transition support days

Two days designed to help students identified as requiring additional support with transition from primary to secondary school. The days were composed of a variety of lessons including literacy and numeracy. Students were supported by teaching staff, teaching assistants and Year 9 peer mentors.

Thursday: Year 10 English and maths support day

A day composed of English and maths support for carefully identified students. Designed to aid catch-up following the school closures and to instil positive learning attitudes before the start of term. Lessons delivered by English and maths specialists.

Friday: Year 9 English and maths support day

A day composed of English and maths support for carefully identified students. Designed to aid catch-up following the school closures and to instil positive learning attitudes before the start of term. Lessons delivered by English and maths specialists.

The expenditure of £4490 covered the staffing costs of teachers; teaching assistants and a science technician.
