Oasis Ely Cancer Hub

The Oasis Ely Cancer Hub has recently been set up to provide wellbeing support to those experiencing cancer in Ely and its surrounding towns and villages. Oasis is a community-spirited platform that is here to signpost and connect people to the practical help available.

We believe that looking after our physical, mental and emotional condition is very important especially at the point of diagnosis and during and after treatment. Oasis aims to provide well-being support to people closer to where they live and so dealing with the barriers that some face in travelling. Oasis offers a pleasant environment in which those suffering or those that have suffered from cancer can rebuild confidence, improve their quality of life and find new skills and pastimes to strengthen their resilience.

Oasis ran its first online well-being session in September 2021. Since then we have joined forces with a number of organisations to share knowledge and skills. These include the Cambridge Cancer Help Centre which runs a weekly online mindfulness session with us via Zoom. We have also linked up with The Hive Leisure Centre in Ely, which has agreed to offer new physical exercise and wellbeing face to face sessions specific for cancer patients.

From January 2022, we will start a regular face to face session on Friday mornings at the Community Hall of Ely St Mary's Church in Ely where we will run a wider range of activities. These will include music therapy sessions, creative activities, talks by cancer professionals as well as providing an information point for other help & services.
