<ul> <li>Devising from scratch (Component 1)</li> <li>In this unit students will be introduced to the GCSE course and will learn how to devise and develop a piece of drama from a stimulus. Attention during this unit is placed on collaborative group skills.</li> <li>We will use scripts as a springboard to devising.</li> <li>Performance from Text (Component 2)</li> <li>"From Page to Stage"</li> <li>Students will perform in two play extracts which will be a combination of monologue, duologue and group performance.
