Year 10 Taster Days – College of West Anglia – Tuesday 2nd July

Places will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. The sessions available are Animal Management or Equine.

Your child's session will be confirmed by The College of West Anglia after the deadline date, and details will also be shared with the school to check attendance on the day.

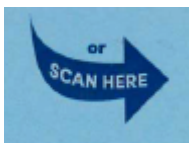
Timings
