Re: Revision timetable building workshop

Year 11 have made a brilliant start to the year and are showing the focus and positive attitudes that will give them the best chance of success in the summer of 2026. Year 11 mock exams will start in early November and last for approximately two weeks. These are the most significant exams students have taken to date in their education. They will have exams in every subject they study and the results will form the basis of the predictions on their post-16 applications. In the session, we will look at how to practically go about organising and planning revision to fit in amongst the other commitments they have. They will learn about the psychology behind habit formation and how to study as efficiently as possible for the maximum benefit.
