Year 11 reports

The purpose of this snapshot is to give you an early update on the teachers' impressions of your child's attitudes to work in their different subjects. We will issue a further report in early December which will include current grades and predicted grades based predominantly on their mock grades but also on their work over the past year. This will be the most robust information to date and will give a strong indication of the likely outcomes in the summer. Parents' Evening will follow in early January and a full report will be available on 20 April 2026.

Year 11 mock exams

Mock exams are fast approaching and will begin at the start of November. We know from past experience that many students find the November exams more stressful than the actual GCSEs. We want students to take the exams seriously but not to the detriment of their health. A lot of the stress can be relieved by a clear revision plan with scheduled breaks and 'down time'.
