Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our partnership with the Fitzwilliam Museum, the whole of year 7 have the opportunity to take part in a trip to the Fitzwilliam Museum in Cambridge.

This is an exciting opportunity for all students to experience the museum with the expert input of museum staff and to appreciate a range of cultural objects and how they relate to our past and present. When students come back to school, they will be applying what they have seen in a number of subject areas, in a variety of ways.

The trip is fully funded by our partnership with the museum and the Friends of Soham Village College, so there is nothing to pay. Students will leave school at 9am and be back at school during lunchtime on the day of the trip, so there is no need for a packed lunch. They will need to wear school uniform, bring writing equipment and their books for periods 4 and 5.

Because the whole year group is involved, the trips are staggered over 5 days and students will be going in their teaching groups.
