Yr11 Apprenticeship support workshop

I am writing to inform you about an apprenticeship support workshop that is being held on **Wednesday 22nd April, period 1 in the Ennion Room**, and to invite you to register your child to attend if interested.

Apprenticeships offer young people an alternative gateway into the world of work – a job which enables them to learn, gain experience and earn a salary at the same time. Apprenticeships cover a broad range of sectors, including healthcare, business & administration, construction, design, digital, accountancy and law, to name but a few. We consistently have a good number of Year 11 students who leave to take up an apprenticeship, and this qualification is highly regarded both in the world of work as well as by many universities.

The workshop will be run by the school careers team and will provide students with support in how to research and apply for an apprenticeship, plus give insider guidance on how to greatly improve the chances of securing an apprenticeship role. We will be supported by some apprentices currently working for G's Growers who will be able to share some practical advice to students.

This workshop is ideal for anyone whose first choice is an apprenticeship, or anybody who has applied for a college course but is also interested in considering an apprenticeship as another option. I am limiting the number of attendees to 20 and places will be allocated on a first come first serve basis.
