Year 10 – Abbeygate College Taster Day – Monday 29th June 2026

Abbeygate Sixth Form College (Bury St Edmunds) have announced details of their Yr10 Taster Day. Taster days provide students who are considering applying to a specific college in the autumn term an opportunity to visit and tour the campus, and take part in lessons related to subjects they are interested in.

To register for their preferred taster sessions, your child should use the Google Form link below. The form is also available on their Careers Google Classroom. The registration deadline is **Friday 5th June**. Allocation of subject sessions will take place on a first come first serve basis. Once a subject has reached its capacity, it will be removed from the options list.

Once the college has received the registration and places allocated, this list will be shared with the school and your child's place will be confirmed.

Timings: Arrival to Abbeygate is at 10.15am for a 10.45am session start. Students are to gather by the bike racks, to the right of the main entrance, at 10.15am where a member of SVC staff will meet them. Departure is at 1.35pm.
