Dear Parents and Carers

Music Tuition - Academic Year 2026/2027 for Year 11: Instrumental & Voice.

We are again pleased to offer to our students individual tuition in a wide range of musical instruments & voice for the next academic year on the terms and conditions detailed below.

For students entering **Years 11** in September 2026, the college guarantees **20 lessons** over the course of the academic year. The annual cost of these lessons is £347.00. As summarised below, parents/carers have the option of paying for the lessons in full at the start of the academic year or opting for 10 monthly payments. Payments in full should be made by BACS. If you choose to pay monthly, these payments can be made by standing order, which parents will have to set up themselves.

As we are committed to paying the instrumental/voice teachers for the full year, we request that parents/carers sign up for a full year's lessons. Students will not be able to cease lessons mid-term and we would like to draw your attention to this area of the contract. If you are in receipt of free school meals, or qualify for Pupil Premium funding, some financial help may be available for these lessons. Please contact Miss Perry for further information.

All tuition is delivered during the school day. Individual lesson times are shown on the termly Music Tuition timetables displayed on noticeboards the Performing Arts Centre. It is the responsibility of students to remember to attend tuition, and to check these timetables each week on the morning of their lesson, if possible, prior to Registration with their Form Tutor. Lessons take place on the same day each week, but where possible the lesson time is rotated so that students do not miss the same academic subject each week. Students must excuse themselves in advance from their academic classes with the class teacher.
