Dear Parent / Carer

Promoting health and wellbeing is an Anglian Learning priority. Anglian Learning offer a webinar series for parents to support with this: '[Mental Health it is not all in the Mind](#)'. In addition, they are adopting an early identification and support programme for students. This wellbeing assessment helps us to understand student wellbeing and plan early support where needed.

We will be using the Artemis-A assessment in order to carry out the initial assessment. Students will complete a short online questionnaire (4–5 questions) in school.

Participation is voluntary, but we encourage students to join in as part of our commitment to their wellbeing. All pupils who take part will be shown general mental-health resources and reminded of the support available in school.

The Artemis-A assessment will not be anonymous. This allows the school's wellbeing team and the Designated Safeguarding Leads (DSLs) to identify students who may need extra support. If a student's responses suggest higher-than-expected distress, and we are not already working with you as a family, a member of the safeguarding or wellbeing team will be in touch to discuss next steps.

We collect a small amount of background information as part of the assessment (age, gender, ethnicity and SEND status). This information is used only by Anglian Learning to help monitor and improve support. Access is limited to DSLs and appropriate school leaders.

Data is stored securely in a system provided and maintained by the University of Cambridge, which hosts the Artemis-A assessment. Records are kept only while a student remains on roll and are permanently deleted once they leave the school. A full Data Protection Impact Assessment has been completed, and all processes comply with UK data-protection law.
